





The Mitt is lightweight and breathable like clothing, and has a range of easily interchangeable tools designed specifically for the activities that you love.



Sizing your Mitt




Two measurements is all you need for us to size your Mitt.


- 1. The length from the inside crease of your elbow to the tip of your limb (in cm)
- 2. The circumference of your forearm (in cm)

Getting Started with your Mitt

How to wear your Mitt sleeve?




Ensure the laces are facing downwards.




Slide your arm into the sleeve. Ensure your elbow pokes out of the hole on the underside of sleeve. Push your limb as close to the end of the sleeve as is comfortable for you.


How to tighten your Mitt sleeve?




How to use a tool with your Mitt sleeve?



Line up the tool with the sleeve.




Let the tool **snap** into place and you're ready to use it.




Pull the top of the tool away from the sleeve.


Using your Mitt


There are lots of tools that can be attached to the sleeve which serve different purposes













Lego Tool

A tool which allows lego to be built onto it



Musical Bow Tool

A tool which holds a string instrument bow such as a cello with an adjustable angle



Nail Holder

A tool to hold nails stable when hammering them into a surface



Racket Tool

A tool which holds various sports rackets and similar equipment



Rotating Tool

A universal tool for various objects with an adjustable angle



Saw Holder

A tool which holds a small saw



Skipping Rope Tool

A tool which holds a skipping rope



Typing Tool

A generic typing tool resembling a single 'finger'



Taking care of your Mitt

Safety

- Ensure the sleeve is comfortable and not overtightened
- Check your arm regularly to ensure there is no redness and irritations
- If the Mitt causes marking on your skin that does not go away after 20 minutes then the sleeve is too tight and should be loosened
- Ensure foam tongue is over the end of your limb
- Ensure the end of your limb is at the front of the sleeve
- Make sure the sleeve is right way up with the tool dock sitting on the inside of your arm
- Keep the sleeve and tools away from fire
- Keep the sleeve and tools away from high power/speed machinery
- Do not attempt to lift or carry objects heavier than 5kg
- Designed for home use do not use for extreme sports
- Mind your fingers when attaching tools
- Use the knife and saw holder tool with caution
- Be aware the sleeve and tools product contains magnets, keep a safe distance between (50mm +) between the magnets and all objects that can be damaged by magnetism

Maintenance & Cleaning

- Only hand wash the sleeve
- Remove tools before washing
- Wipe tools with damp cloth to clean
- Store the sleeve and tools somewhere dry
